






Planned & Guided Tours include:

Round trip airfare to Paris from Minneapolis and many US cities.

Ground transfers to and from the boat to Paris (train, car, or taxi service).

A cabin on Locaboat's FB1500 (each cabin sleeps 2).

Collision insurance, fuel charge, and bike rental.

One week of guided canal boat cruising (7 days and 7 nights).

Operating the boat (you are welcome to try your hand at driving).

Initial provisioning of the boat (inc. dry goods, cleaning supplies and food).

History tidbits along our route.

Savvy Nomad Tasting & Tours Terms and Conditions

Terms and Conditions

1. Reservation

A confirmation of reservation with The Travel Company LLC, doing business as Savvy Nomad, automatically initiates the terms below. Your contract is with Savvy Nomad and a contract exists as soon as you sign your reservation request.

2. Payment Terms

A. At the time the canal boat travel is scheduled and approved a thirty-five percent (35%) initial payment of \$1330 per person is due. Second payment of 35% (\$1330/person) is due March 1st, 2019. Final payment of \$1140 (plus any special request add-ons) will be invoiced in May/June with the remaining balance due upon receipt of invoice.

B. All payments are based on double occupancy. If a single cabin is required for one individual, there will be an additional charge of \$1000.

3. Cancellation Terms

To cancel a reservation please notify Savvy Nomad in writing. If the boat schedule has been approved and the boat reserved, a \$1000 cancellation fee will be assessed. The cancellation fee is waived if the hirer replaces themselves with a new reserver. If any scheduled payment is not received, Savvy Nomad reserves the right to cancel the contract and retain all fees paid to that date.

4. Travel Insurance

Travel Insurance (cancellation insurance and medical emergency insurance) is highly recommended. Savvy Nomad can provide travel insurance quotes at many different levels. Please inquire about insurance and or sign an insurance waiver.

5. Travel Periods and Routes

Unless otherwise agreed upon, the travel is for the agreed upon dates for the canal boating portion of your trip. Extra time at the beginning and/or the end of the canal boating week are at your discretion and will be charged at the rate in which Savvy Nomad is charged for making any arrangements. Savvy Nomad will act as your travel agent for the canal boating period of your travel, will arrange travel to and from the boat, and will, at your request, arrange additional travel in France or Europe. Once travel dates are agreed upon and airfare purchased the traveler will be responsible for any additional fees or charges that should arrive due to date changes in the schedule.

6. Delivery of Product

Savvy Nomad is the guide and coordinator of products delivered by multiple third party vendors. We will make every effort to insure that the services contracted will be fulfilled. If the services are not delivered by the vendor as promised we will advocate for you in resolving the issue. You agree to not hold Savvy Nomad liable for any service not performed by a third party contracted on your behalf.

7. Availability

If due to circumstances beyond Savvy Nomad's control we are unable to provide the vacation as scheduled we will either provide a similar alternative or a full refund at your discretion.

8. Additional Expenses

You agree to pay any additional expenses during your vacation that Savvy Nomad has not specifically expressed as being part of the prepaid vacation package. These include but are not limited to consumable items such as food, drinks, restaurant meals, mooring or docking fees, taxi cab charges, tours, and museum fees.

9. Termination of Vacation and Indemnity

Savvy Nomad reserves the right in its absolute discretion to terminate, without further notice, the vacation arrangements for anyone who refuses to comply with the instructions or orders from Savvy Nomad and whose behavior or competence in Savvy Nomad's opinion is likely to cause distress, damage, danger or annoyance to other customers, staff or any third party property. Upon such termination Savvy Nomad's responsibility to you ceases and shall not be liable for any costs incurred by you.

10. Restricted or Interrupted Cruising

Savvy Nomad accepts no liability and shall not be bound to make any refund in the event of cruising waters being restricted or the cruise being interrupted as a result of closing waterways for repairs or because of drought, flooding, or any other cause beyond Savvy Nomad's control.

11. Force Majeure

We regret that we cannot accept responsibility or pay compensation where the performance or prompt performance of our contract with you is prevented or affected by any reason of circumstances amounting to "force majeure." For the purpose of this section, circumstances could be but are not limited to any event that Savvy Nomad could not, even with all due care, foresee or avoid, including destruction of the boat due to fire, flood, explosion, storm or weather damage, accident, break-in, criminal damage or any other cause outside our control.

12. Governing Law and Venue

This contract shall be constructed and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Minnesota. The venue for any proceeding hereunder shall lie in St. Louis County, Minnesota.

13. WAIVER/ASSUMPTION OF RISK/RELEASE OF LIABILITY

You agree to assume all risks of participating in the vacation and release Savvy Nomad from any liability for loss, damage, or injury (including disability or death) to your person and property while attending, participating in, or becoming involved with the vacation. You specifically make the following representations and assurances to Savvy Nomad, acknowledging that Savvy Nomad would not permit your participation in the vacation without receiving such representations and assurances:

I wish to participate in a Savvy Nomad vacation subject to the terms and conditions herein. I acknowledge and agree that the vacation involves some inherently dangerous activities. Savvy Nomad will use good faith efforts to conduct and manage the vacation, but I understand that it is not possible to make the vacation completely safe. I warrant and represent that I am sufficiently knowledgeable, skilled and/or informed regarding the vacation to properly and fully judge the inherent risks of the vacation.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK. I acknowledge and agree that the vacation involves potential risks of serious personal injury, disability or even death. I represent that I have sufficient physical fitness to participate in the vacation and I have no medical reason or impairment that might otherwise prevent me from participating in the vacation. If I know or should know of any condition or problem that might prevent me from safely participating in the vacation, I agree that I will immediately advise Savvy Nomad and remove myself from the vacation should the strain on myself prove immediately detrimental to my life and lifestyle.

In consideration of participating in or become involved with the a Savvy Nomad vacation, I hereby assume full responsibility for my own safety and accept all known and unanticipated risks of loss, damage, and injury (including death or disability) to myself and my property while attending, participating in, or becoming involved with the vacation, regardless of whether or not such risks are attributable to the negligence of others. By assuming and accepting all known and unanticipated risks, I completely absolve, waive, discharge, and release Savvy Nomad and all its employees, advisors, consultants, members, contractors, organizers, operators, volunteers, sponsors, or other persons affiliated with Savvy Nomad and all facility staff, guests, fellow participants, landlords, owners, management companies and the like (collectively the "Indemnified Parties") from any legal duty for my safety or any liability for my harm, to the maximum extent permitted by law.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY. In consideration of participating in or become involved with a Savvy Nomad vacation, I hereby agree to release, waive, discharge, hold harmless, defend and indemnify the Indemnified Parties from and against any and all liability, claims, demands, controversy, lawsuits or possible causes of action ("Claims") that may accrue or arise from any loss, damage, or injury (including death or disability) to my person and property that is in any way related to or arising in connection with my attendance at, participation in, or involvement with the vacation, regardless of whether or not such Claims are attributable in whole or in part to any act, omission, or negligence of the Indemnified Parties. I agree that the Indemnified Parties will not be legally responsible for any loss, damage, and injury (including death or disability) to my person and property arising out of or in any way connected to the vacation, however caused and on any theory of liability whatsoever (whether in contract, tort, negligence, strict liability or otherwise), including but not limited to the Indemnified Parties' own negligence. Such defense and indemnification shall include all reasonable costs, expenses and attorneys' fees that may be associated with any Claims. I further agree that I will not cause, encourage, promulgate, support or cooperate with (unless such cooperation is judicially mandated) any Claims to be brought against the Indemnified Parties.

I understand that the above release and assumption of risk is intended to provide a comprehensive release of liability but is not intended to assert any defenses that are prohibited by law. The release and assumption of risk shall be enforceable to the fullest extent allowed by law. If any portion of the release and assumption of risk is held invalid, those parts that are not held invalid shall continue in full force and effect. The terms of the above release and assumption of risk shall apply to and be binding on myself, my spouse, my heirs, all members of my family, executors, administrators, representatives, and assigns.
